



## ENMU – Ruidoso Emergency Medical Services Program

### EMT-B and AEMT Pre-Admission Information

*PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.*

The following requirements must be in place for all students enrolled in either EMT Basic or Advanced EMT programs.

- 1) Students must have **current immunizations** (see ENMU-R EMS Immunization Requirements Worksheet). You will need to obtain any needed immunizations at an outside clinic or doctor's office. It is recommended you make an appointment with your doctor as soon as you have registered here to ensure you have all immunizations and/or to get what is missing. Students are responsible for all costs associated with the update of their immunizations.
- 2) A background check, will be coordinated the first week in class through your instructor (the background check cost is included in student fees).
- 3) The cost of the 10-panel drug screen has been included in student fees. Your lead instructor will arrange for White Sands Drug & Alcohol to collect samples during regularly scheduled class times within the first few weeks of class (to be announced and confirmed).
- 4) Advanced EMT students must:
  1. Possess a current BLS for the healthcare provider card, or other advance CPR certification. A list of accepted cards can be found on the [NM EMS Bureau website](#), under their licensing section
  2. Copy of NM EMT Basic license
- 5) After the completion of the course students must sign up for and successfully complete the National Registry exam to become licensed. EMT Basic students are only required to take the cognitive portion of the exam for a cost of approximately \$70.00. Advanced EMT students are required to take both a cognitive and psychomotor portion of the exam for an approximate total cost of \$150.00.
