

# Occupational Safety and Health

## Certificate of Completion

21 credit hours

The Certificate of Completion in Occupational Safety & Health is a one-year program that is intended to ensure that students acquire the intellectual knowledge and technical skills that will enable them to advance in the safety field through organizational advancement and professional certification. This certificate fulfills the needs of entry-level safety personnel who wish to gain professional stature.

Upon program completion students will be able to:

- Demonstrate the Occupational/Safety and Health skills needed to meet the demand in the industry.
- Demonstrate the skills needed to keep compliance with current regulatory agencies to create a safe and healthy work environment for employees.
- Demonstrate the skills needed to continue toward progressively advanced credentials, such as the designations of Certificate; Associate of Applied Science; and Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences.

All Courses offered online.
