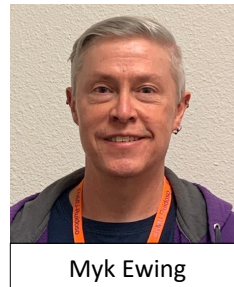
### ENMU-Ruidoso Received \$63,000 Grant for Construction Trades

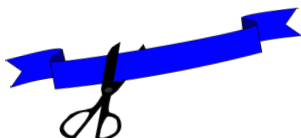
