- ◆ 39% of students at two- and four-year colleges had experienced food insecurity in the last 30 days
- ◆ 35% of students said their hunger had impacted their ability to study.
- ◆ More than 1/3 of students knew someone who had dropped out of school due to their ability to afford food
- ◆ Students who deal with hunger often get lower grads and tend to withdraw before completing their degree or certificate.
