Call for Kids College Class Proposals

Kids College will be held July 24-28 Monday-Friday, half- or full-day. ENMU-Ruidoso is seeking enthusiastic and creative instructors to teach classes for the summer enrichment program for students who have completed kindergarten through eighth grades. Teaching credentials are not required but expertise and enthusiasm in a subject are essential. Instructors are needed in many subject areas. Instructor compensation is \$20/student/one-week class. Scan the QR code to the right to submit course proposals. They must be for one hour/day for all five days. Target class sizes are 5-12 students. Background checks are required. Proposals are due by June 12.
