Congrats to Chevenne Kissee-Dowdell Who Placed First in **Conference Presentation**

Academic and Student Support Specialist Cheyenne Kissee-Dowdell won first place in her category at the 2023 Student Research and Creativity Conference at ENMU Portales with her presentation on diversity in videogames. She was awarded a cash prize of \$150 at the event. Dowdell created her content analysis project for her class, Sociology of Media. She examined



a piece of video game media, Assassin's Creed, in order to determine whether or not it was diverse with its representation of minorities. She is pursuing a bachelor's degree in Sociology with a minor in Information Systems. After the completion of her degree, she plans on continuing her career at ENMU-Ruidoso.

Community Development Receives \$25,000 Grant for Kids College

ENMU-Ruidoso Community Development department received a \$25,000 grant from the New Mexico Out-of-School Time Network for the 2023 Kids College summer enrichment program. The grant provides funds for the projected participation of 50 students for the week-long program, July 24-28. The grant allows students who have completed kindergarten through 8th grades to attend Kids College for free and allows increased pay for instruc-


