# Welcome Miss Rodeo New Mexico Emma Cameron and the Miss Rodeo New Mexico Pageant

The Miss Rodeo New Mexico Queen Pageant will be hosted at ENMU-Ruidoso Saturday, Sept. 30. The pageant consists of four age categories for young women. The Miss Rodeo New Mexico contest is for young ladies ages 20-25, Miss Teen is for ages 16-19, the Princess Pageant is for ages 11-15 and the Little Miss is for girls ages 6-10.



Two contestants will be compete for the Miss Rodeo New Mexico title, two for the Miss Teen title, one for the Princess title and five for the Little Miss title. The pageant contestants will be judged on horsemanship, speeches, modeling, impromptu questions, a personal interview and a written test. The horsemanship portion of the pageant will be held Friday at 1 p.m. at the Grande Vista Equine Stables, 464 State Hwy 220, Alto. The fashion show, speeches, impromptu questions, modeling and coronation will be held at the college. It is open to the public in Room 201 at 2 p.m. Doors will open at 1:30 p.m.

Miss Rodeo New Mexico Emma Cameron was raised in Santa Fe and competed in rodeos, 4-H and AQHA shows. In 2018 she served as the National High School Rodeo Queen before moving to New York to attend Cornell University where she graduated with honors. She is a Commodity Risk Management Analyst where she works one-on-one with agriculture producers to help them understand market dynamics and manage their price risk. She will compete at the Miss Rodeo America Pageant in Las Vegas, Nev., Dec. 3-10.
