## CDL Class A Offered March 18

Community Development is offering the Commercial Driver License (CDL) Class A for five weeks beginning March 18. The course familiarizes students with tractor/trailer semis and provides the fundamental knowledge and skills to prepare students for a career as a professional truck driver. Students will receive classroom instruction, learn to back and maneuver the vehicle and learn to follow the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Association (FMCSA) guidelines. Students will practice driving on a closed driving range, and on public roadways with a qualified driver instructor. Prerequisites include DOT medical card, MVD driving record and a copy of current drug test. Tuition is \$4,250. Students must be at least 18 years of age. The first week includes theoretical training 8 a.m.-2 p.m. followed with four weeks of behind-the-wheel training. [Register now.](#)

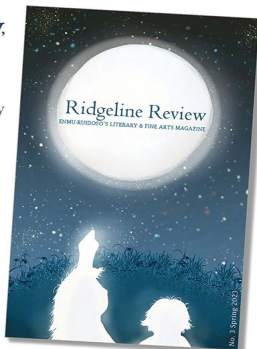
