

Free Waterwise Lecture Tuesday 5 p.m.

Geologist and Geophysicist Cynthia Black will present a free lecture Tuesday, Feb. 27 at 5 p.m. titled “Waterwise: How Lincoln County’s Geology affects its Aquifers.” Black was born in Houston, Texas and is the oldest of six girls. All her life she made annual trips to the family cabin in the Upper Canyon. She has a bachelor’s degree from Aberdeen University, Scotland, and a master’s degree from Texas A&M. She began full-time geological work in 1982 in Midland for Exxon and later worked for Arco Permian, Burlington Resources, and Occidental Petroleum, as well as consulting for a number of clients, including geothermal energy companies in California. She has worked in Texas, New Mexico, Colorado, Wyoming, Utah and California. She retired from California Resources Corporation as chief geophysicist and moved to her permanent home in Lincoln County where she continues to investigate local geology and water resources, along with intermittent consulting work.
