### 5-Week CDL Class A begins July 8-Aug. 9

The CTE Department is hosting a CDL Class A training for 5 weeks, July 8-Aug. 9. The course familiarizes students with semi tractors/trailers and provides the fundamental knowledge and skills to prepare students for a career as a professional truck driver. The class includes one week of classroom instruction, followed by four weeks of hands-on driving maneuvers and learn to follow the FMCSA guidelines. Students will practice driving on a closed driving range, and on public roadways with a driver instructor. Prerequisites include a DOT medical card, MVD driving record and a copy of a current drug test. Students must be at least 18 years of age. Testing is coordinated by El Paso Mountain View Testing Center and will be scheduled the week after the course is completed. Tuition/fees are \$4,250 which includes driving permitting, training and licensing. \$100 boots optional. [Click here to register.](#)
