Healing in the Mountains Event Saturday, Aug. 17, 10 a.m.-4 p.m.

A collaborative healing event for Lincoln County Communities will be held at ENMU-Ruidoso, Learning Commons, Saturday, Aug. 17, 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Practitioners and healing modalities that will be available include: grief and trauma specialists, therapists, chair massages, trauma-sensitive somatic movement, mindfulness-based stress reduction, therapy dogs, chiropractic and nervous system health specialists, emotional freedom techniques, herbal remedies, youth and children support, spiritual support and sound healing. The event objective is to provide our communities affected by the wildfires and flooding an opportunity for health and wellness healing; provide basic grief and traumatic stress knowledge, and healing modalities to help residents and our first responders understand and validate their experience; and encourage community healing and support—knowing we are never expected to deal with grief alone. This event will provide tools and resources by local practitioners to begin the process of healing and recovery in a safe and trusting space.
