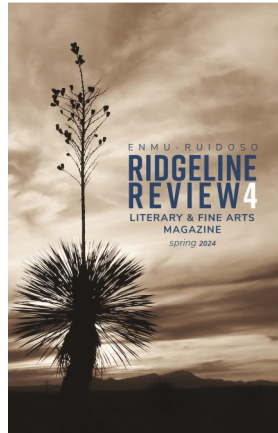

4th Edition of *Ridgeline Review* Available

In August 2024, the fourth issue of *Ridgeline Review*, ENMU-Ruidoso's community-focused literary and arts magazine, was published. The issue was produced by six ENMU-Ruidoso students and two student alumni, including four dual-credit students from Ruidoso High School. Fifty-five writers and artists were published in this issue, a record for the magazine. This includes ENMU-Ruidoso students and staff; local high school students; community members throughout Lincoln and Otero counties; and folks who've connected with the publication through student-run social media. As always, the magazine aims to give a voice and publication opportunities to our campus and to rural southern New Mexicans. For most folks, this was their first publication opportunity. The issue was funded by a generous grant from the Southern New Mexico Community Foundation. ENMU-Ruidoso staff member Jocelyn Rose served as design editor for the issue, and English Faculty Jeff Frawley served as advisor and editor.
