To be a Peer Mentor students must be enrolled at ENMU-Ruidoso and maintain a 3.0 GPA, have completed one semester of coursework, have a strong desire to help fellow students, possess strong verbal and written communication skills, are aware and sensitive to individual learning styles, and are able to apply study strategies, goal setting, organizational skills and time management in mentoring sessions. Peer Mentors will receive training through workshops, role-playing exercises and interactive discussions. These are paid student employment opportunities. Mentors will also receive ongoing support and additional training opportunities throughout the semester.
