CDL License Course

Starting Sept. 16

Class A: 200 Hrs.
1 Week Theoretical Training, 8 a.m.-3 p.m.
4 Weeks Behind-the-Wheel Training

The course familiarizes students with semi-tractor/trailers and provides the fundamental knowledge and skills to prepare for a career as a professional driver. Students will receive classroom instruction, learn to back and maneuver the vehicle and learn to follow the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Association (FMCSA) guidelines. Students will practice driving on a closed driving range, and on public roadways with a qualified driver instructor. Testing will be coordinated with Mountain View Testing Center in El Paso. Testing will be scheduled the week after course completion.

Prerequisites: DOT Medical Card, MVD Driving Record and a copy of Current Drug Test. Tuition must be paid in full. Must be at least 18 years old.

Tuition / Fees \$4,250 - includes permitting, theoretical and behind-the-wheel training and licensing.
