Free Lecture by NMSU Assistant Professor & Extension Entomologist Dr. Joanie King Oct. 29

A free lecture—*Insectwise: Insects of New Mexico—the Beneficials and the Pests* will be held at ENMU-Ruidoso Tuesday, Oct. 29, 5-7 p.m. in Room 201. The lecture is presented by the Alto Coalition for Environmental Preservation and the Community Development Office. The lecture will be presented by NMSU Assistant Professor and Extension Entomology Specialist Dr. Joanie King. She earned a doctorate degree in entomology from Texas A&M University, a master's degree of science in entomology from the University of Georgia, and a bachelor's degree of science in biology from the University of Central Florida. Alongside her Extension and outreach focus, Dr. King's lab focuses on host-parasite interactions, community ecology, and integrated pest management (IPM). In addition to serving the NMSU community through Extension and research, she is active in the Entomological Society of America. "Sharing bug science is cool!" says Dr. King.
