Sign up for ENMU-Ruidoso Emergency Notifications with RAVE Mobile Safety

The RAVE Emergency Notification System notifies registered members/ENMU-Ruidoso students, faculty and staff of emergencies (including weather delays and other environmental issues) via text messages, emails, and phone calls.

- ◆ To sign up go to www.getrave.com
- ◆ Type in Eastern New Mexico University Ruidoso
- ◆ Click Register on the right side of the page.
- ◆ Fill out your personal information. You must use your ENMU email address to sign up, but you can add personal emails and phone numbers (including speech-to-text voice messages) once you are registered.
- ◆ You will then receive a confirmation email and text. Please validate your email and cell numbers. It ensures proper delivery of notifications if there is an emergency.

Once your account is set up you will need to confirm your phone number(s) and email(s) in MY ACCOUNT.
