

ENMU-Ruidoso represented at End Hunger Day & N.M. Higher Ed Day

The New Mexico Higher Education Department hosted Higher Education Day at the Roundhouse Feb. 25 giving colleges and universities the opportunity to set up an information table and meet with legislators regarding capital outlay requests. ENMU-Ruidoso campus capital outlay funding requests include a total of \$305,000; \$200,000 for retaining wall improvements in the lower area on the south side of the parking lot and \$105,000 for science lab updates that would improve and expand the science lab with advance technology and modernize resources. Due to the expansion of allied health programs on campus, the needs have increased in the lab area to include new anatomical models, software, simulation equipment, and chemical and biological specimens.

Additionally, this year, due to ENMU-Ruidoso Community Development & Grants Office receiving the N.M. Higher Education Department Food Security Grant, the college was invited to attend the Legislative Reception at the Food Depot in Santa Fe as well as the End Hunger Day at the Roundhouse Feb. 21.

7-Week Stained Glass begins March 17

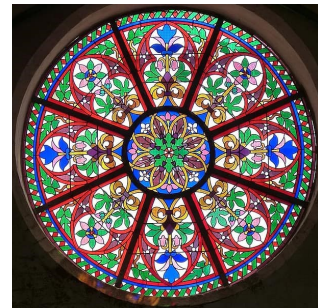
