Two Carlsbad Students Sign Letters of Intent to Golf at ENMU-Ruidoso

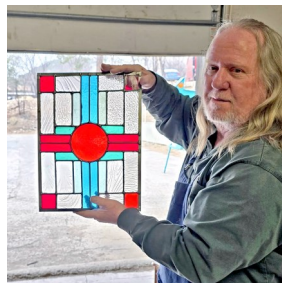

The cost is \$325 that includes basic supplies. The cost is \$100 and includes basic supplies. Both classes will be instructed by William Mack at the N.M. Art Glass Center in Ruidoso.
