Two Stained Glass Classes Offered this Summer

The Community Development Office is offering a 7-week <u>Basic Stained Glass Class</u> that began June 13 and is offered Wednesdays and Fridays each week from 5-7 p.m. at the N.M. Art Glass Center in Ruidoso. In this Introduction to the Art of Stained Glass students will learn the basics of safety, tools and hardware, designing, cutting, glass selection, foiling, soldering and cleaning techniques. The cost is \$325 that includes basic supplies. A <u>Suncatcher Stained Glass Class</u> is being offered for three weeks that started June 16 on Mondays and Tuesdays 5-7 p.m. also at the N.M. Art Glass Center. The cost is \$100 and includes basic supplies. Students will learn the introduction to copper foiling. Both classes will be instructed by William Mac. Late registrations are still being accepted.
