Congrats to Three Area Registered Nursing Students

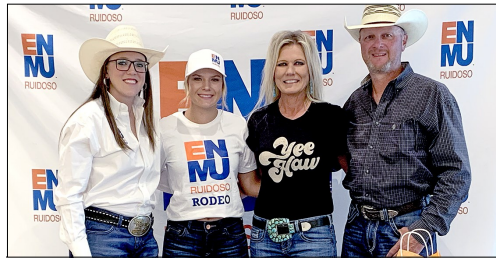
