Constitution Speaker Judge Angie K. Schneider Sept. 17 at 11 a.m., Learning Commons

In celebration of Constitution Day Wednesday, Sept. 17, Judge Angie K. Schneider will speak at 11 a.m. in the Learning Commons. The Honorable Schneider is a judge for the 12th Judicial District Court of New Mexico in Otero County. She was appointed to the bench by former Governor Susana Martinez in July 2013, filling the vacancy created by the retirement of the Hon. William H. Brogan (Ret.).

The 12th Judicial District includes Otero and Lincoln Counties. During her judicial tenure, Schneider has served as Chief Judge of the 12th Judicial District. Prior to her appointment she managed her own private practice, the Law Offices of Angie K. Schneider. Schneider received a Bachelors' degree from the University of New Mexico. She went on to complete a J.D. at the University of New Mexico School of Law. She was admitted to the law practice in New Mexico in 2001. Her memberships have included the 12th Judicial District Bar Association and the State Bar of New Mexico. She sat on the Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee and has been involved with HEAL (Help End Abuse for Life), Rotary Club, the Assisted Outpatient Treatment work group, and the High Mountain Youth Project.

In 2018, Schneider received a gubernatorial appointment to serve on the Substitute Care Advisory Council, which is tasked with examining policy, procedures, and practices of the Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD).
