The ENMU-Ruidoso Men's Golf team, both freshmen Robbie Rodriquez and Anthony "Jace" Hernandez, made their collegiate debut at Southwestern Christian Invitational Sept. 2-3 in Oklahoma City, Okla. The duo teed it up for the first time at their opening college tournament, facing both challenging weather and nerves that often come with a first outing at this level. The opening round on Tuesday was slowed by heavy rain that persisted through the early hours. Wet conditions made the course play longer and more demanding, forcing both golfers to battle through soggy fairways and slower greens.
