BOARD ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman Treptow congratulated staff and the board effort regarding the groundbreaking. He noted Dr. Carstens presentation to Rotary. He also reminded the board of the upcoming board retreat and local election, which three members are running in.

PRESIDENT REPORT

Dr. Carstens read highlights from the College Report, which includes summaries of staff and faculty initiatives since May.

INFORMATION ITEMS

1. Strategic Plan Update: Goal One: Dr. Carstens discusses highlights from the Strategic Plan Update report. Chairman Treptow asked what faculty had not yet participated in QM Training. Dr. Carstens responded that all new resource faculty have to be trained. The board also requested to meet the campus' new IT Director.

- 2. Update on Board Retreat: Dr. Carstens outlined the schedule of the board retreat to members. He also requested a paragraph bio for each member. The Aspen Parade was also discussed; ENMU-Ruidoso will be participating, despite the retreat.
- 3. Bond Update: Mr. Steve Lestarjette provided updates of the bond, and growing support from the community. Elevations edition three is in progress, new senior newsletter, Pinnacle is also in production. The board unanimously expressed support over Elevations newsletter. Mr. Lestarjette also discussed collaboration with Ruidoso Municipal school.
- 4. College Enrollment Summer and Fall: Dr. Carstens discussed the fall and summer 2019 enrollment and FTE statistics: Summer FTE rose by 21%; Fall headcount and FTE up 17.7%. Dr. Carstens noted the growth on campus from Mescalero enrollments and thanked the Marketing Enrollment Roundup events for success. The board expressed appreciation for the college staff's efforts.

1. Certificate of Occupational Training – Culinary Fundamentals – Ms. Omness explained the rationale, need and design of the culinary fundamentals program. She explained that Inn of the Mountain Gods asked the college to provide basic culinary training for their workforce. The college met with the Inn to compile a program that fit their basic needs.
