1. Position 4 Board Member Candidate Selection

Chair Brad Treptow discussed the background of the Position 4 opening. Mid-August 2021, President Trospen received the resignation for Member Justin Huffmon. Member Huffmon relocated outside of Ruidoso and ENMU-Ruidoso Community College Board accepted Member Huffmon's formal resignation on October 14, 2021. Chair Brad Treptow initiated a request for possible candidates. Recommendations were received from Member Gina Klinekole and President Ryan Trospen.

Chair Treptow called each candidate with questions regarding their interest in the ENMU-Ruidoso campus and the responsibilities of the Community College Board. Reelection for this position will be in two years and was discussed with each candidate. Tours of ENMU-Ruidoso campus were provided to the four potential candidates with President Trospen and Ms. Marla Frye-Romero.

All candidates were highly qualified and would be encouraged to be involved with our campus in the future. With only one vacancy this recommendation was challenging but is being presented with the experience of long standing in the community and a connection to the ENMU-Ruidoso Campus. This candidate shows a willingness to run and provide stability in the future. Chair Brad Treptow recommended Romelia (Romy) Carr to be selected to fill Position 4 for the ENMU-Ruidoso Community College Board.

Chair Treptow asks for questions from the board. Member Marla Frye-Romero, agreed with it being a tough decision. All candidates were exceptional. Member Gina Klinekole had no questions or no comments. Member Murray Murphy had no questions. President Ryan Trospen stated it was wonderful to show the college growth by the interest of the 4 candidates. Supports board on any of the candidates. However, the recommended candidate does bring community passion, engagement, and works with the Village of Ruidoso. Chair Treptow recommended a joint letter of appreciation to other candidates for their time and interest. We would like to invite them into our college in another capacity.
