Report from ENMU System Chancellor

Dr. James Johnston reported progress on One Eastern Initiative, began phase one. End goal to allow any student at one of the three campuses to transfer to any of the three campuses. Next meeting is about Banner. He is optimistic about the upcoming Legislative session

Report from ENMU-Ruidoso Foundation Director

Awarded 20 Fall scholarships to seven new and 13 returning students. Donor reception last week hosted 38 individuals on campus. Spring scholarship deadline is January 10th. inaugural event last month to highlight purpose and welcomed 35 guests. Clay shoot fundraiser set for June 2024. Planning an Alumni event for next Fall 2024. Financial position as of October 31, 2023 nearing \$300,000.

Report from ENMU-Ruidoso Community College Board Chair

Chair Treptow expressed congratulations on the bond passing with 69% and on the Community College Board re-election.

Report from ENMU-Ruidoso President

President Trosper introduced Gray Mowery, Workforce Youth Career Coach. Gray was a teacher for 4 years prior to coming on with Workforce. He has 4 individuals on is caseload 16-24 years of age. Director of Oso Productions with an upcoming production December 22-24 at ENMU-Ruidoso.

Current enrollment count is at 800 students, FTE 400. There has been an increase in FTE of 22.5% in 5 years, one of only two colleges to do so in double digits. On-campus enrollment up 30%. As of 2023, 530 students on campus compared to 340 in 2018. CDL 5-week training course in progress. Waste water training on campus. Native American Heritage Days November 14-16. Attending AACC and Rural College Commission meetings in Washington D.C. this week. College celebration last week with the campus including Strategic Plan update.

INFORMATION ITEMS

Athletics Update

President Ryan Trosper introduced Delnor Poss and shared his background. Delnor was at Midland College for forty years as Athletic Director and coach. We have been approved for membership into the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association and National Junior College Athletic Association.

Our Rodeo Team will compete in the NIRA Grand Canyon region (NM, AZ). The Cross Country and Golf Teams will compete in the NJCAA Region 5. Next steps: Post Athletic Director/Coach position in December; make purchases using \$200,000 from the legislature; Sport Advisory Groups will be developed.

GO Bond Results

President Ryan Trosper gave information on 2019 GO Bond - passed first bond with 71% with 1,000 less voters. In the 2023 GO Bond election, all but one precinct overwhelmingly supported the bond with 69.2% in favor. 2023 vote was highest percentage of voters in off-year election.

Strategic Plan

President Ryan Trosper thanked Community College Board member Murphy for involvement in working on Strategic Plan.

2024 Legislative Session Priorities

President Ryan Trosper discussed upcoming Legislative Priorities for 2024; \$3 million for Workforce Training.

Capital Outlay request is for STEAM \$125,000, Workforce training \$150,000. Additional funding request include; Nursing Partnership \$178,000.

Position 4 Board Member Candidate Selection

President Ryan Trosper discussed candidate selection. There will need to be an appointment by the Community College Board. The process included a letter of interest, an interview, and a recommendation from Chair Treptow to Community College Board. Two candidates have expressed interest. This position will be filled until the next off-year election. Website graphic was posted November 14.

Report of Actuals

Tony Major, ENMU CFO reported audited numbers. All public information. In the report the first column was what was budgeted, second column is the revised budget and third column are the actuals. The state requires 3% in reserves. ENMU-Ruidoso has 43% of operating budget in reserves. The proposal was to transfer funds from reserves into capital. The passing of the Local GO Bond sends a strong message to Santa Fe.
