ENMU-R EMS Immunization Requirements Worksheet

All EMS students (e.g. EMT-Basic, EMT-Advanced) need to show evidence of having obtained the following immunizations and tests as part of their clinical education compliance. **STUDENTS NEED TO SUBMIT THEIR RECORDS** to David Shriver at shriverd@ruidososchools.org . Below is a complete list of **Required** Immunizations and tests:

1. **Varicella (Chickenpox)**, Students must:

- Proof of TWO (2) doses of Varicella vaccine (each dose in the 2-dose series must be spaced at least 4 weeks apart, with the first dose given **after** 1st birthday)

-Or-

- Have documentation of Titers (IgG) showing immunity for Varicella. COPY OF LAB RESULTS ARE REQUIRED.

2. **Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)**, Students must:

- Have documentation of TWO (2) DOSES after 1980 (each dose in the 2-dose series must be spaced at least 4 weeks apart, with the first dose given after 1st birthday)

-Or-

- Have documentation of Titers (IgG) showing immunity for each disease: Rubeola, Rubella, Mumps. COPY OF LAB RESULTS ARE REQUIRED.

3. **TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis)**, Students must:

- Have documentation of childhood tetanus series

-And-

- Have documentation of Booster dose within last 10 years *Note: You may need a TD if it has been 10 or more years since your last Tdap.*

-Or-

- Have documentation of Tetanus shot within 10 years

4. **Tuberculosis Screening**, Students must:

- Provide documentation of a completed Tuberculosis test with expiration past end of semester

Or-

- History of Positive TB Test: Must provide documentation of PPD result, chest X-ray result, and treatment completion.



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5. Flu Shot: Students must:

- Proof of a Flu Shot for the current year

EMS students are required to bring documents to verify immunization information. Acceptable documentation includes official vaccine records such as:

- World Health Organization Certificate of Vaccination
- Childhood vaccine cards
- State registry printout School records
- Medical records
- Employee Records

If you do not currently have records of your past Immunizations, you may want to check the following:

- Your High School
- State Department of Health
- Pediatrician &/or current PCP's office
