

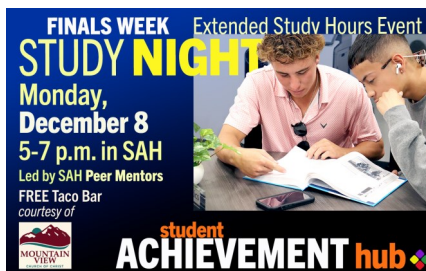

The result is a replicable model that integrates culture, language, and hands-on learning. It was an inspiring panel presentation and showed how great things happen when a community works together.
