Pre-Nursing Student Field Trip to TriCore Laboratory

Science Department Chair Shelly Elfelt and Math/Science Professor Dr. Mohammad "Mo" Yazdi took the ENMU-Ruidoso pre-nursing students from the Science Department to visit the Ruidoso Presbyterian Tri-Core Reference Laboratory. The Lab Manager Katherine Jennings provided the students with a great opportunity for learning and discussions. They were introduced to the Lab's state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment and machines.



The Pre-Nursing Certificate of Occupational Training is a 33-43 credit hour program. This certificate provides students with coursework identified by the New Mexico Nursing Education Consortium (NMNEC) as the common statewide prerequisites and general education courses for an ADN. Students completing this certificate can apply to ENMU-Roswell or any state-founded New Mexico Community College or University and apply for admission into their ADN program. Students must consider that passing mandated background checks and drug screening is a condition of entry into NA/L courses and nursing programs in NM.
