ENMU-Ruidoso Class of 2026, 289 Graduates Announced

ENMU-Ruidoso hosted the 21st Annual Commencement Ceremony on Thursday, May 7, at 6 p.m. at the Inn of the Mountain Gods, Mescalero where 289 diplomas, certificates and degrees were awarded, some students received multiple awards.

This is the largest number of students to be awarded to date in ENMU-Ruidoso's history.

Twenty-four students received their diploma for the New Mexico High School Equivalency (HSE); 180 graduated with a Certificate of Completion in Child Development, Core Curriculum, Cyber Defense Infrastructure Support Specialist, HVAC Technician, Pre-Nursing, Welding Technology and Wildland Fire Science; 43 students graduated with a Certificate of Occupational Training in Culinary Arts Fundamentals, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Nursing Assistant, and Phlebotomy; 9 graduated with an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Business Administration, Information Systems Cybersecurity and Wildland Fire Science; 31 with an Associate of Arts (AA) degree in Business Administration, Early Childhood Education, General Studies, Psychology, Secondary Education and University Studies; and 2 graduated with an Associate of Science (AS) degree in Natural Science.

Additionally, about 14 graduates were presented to receive their Bachelor's degree from ENMU Portales in Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS); Business Administration (BA), Science and University Studies; and for a Master's of Arts (MA) degree in Counseling and a Master's degree of Education (MED) for School Counseling. President's Honor List

ENMU-Ruidoso Branch Community College has released the names of 196 students who qualified for the President's Honor List for the 2026 spring semester. To qualify for the President's List, a student must be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours) and earn a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 (on a 4.0 scale).

Last fall there were 109 students on the honors list and this spring semester's number of 195 reflects a 79% increase in honors students over last fall.
