



SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS

ENMU-Ruidoso is a tobacco-free institution; therefore, the use of any form of tobacco is prohibited in the ENMU-Ruidoso buildings and vehicles.

ENMU-Ruidoso policy and procedures are to provide a smoke-free and tobacco-free environment. The university policy related to smoking and the use of tobacco products is as follows:

- A. The university is dedicated to providing a safe, healthy and low-risk working and learning environment for employees and students.
- B. The goal of a safe, healthy and low-risk university can in part be achieved through elimination of smoking and the use of tobacco products on university property. This policy applies to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, smokeless tobacco, all other tobacco products and other legal smoking preparations, including but not limited to hookahs, electronic cigarettes, clove cigarettes, vapor cigarettes and other legal smoking preparations. Smoking and use of tobacco products is permitted only in a small number of designated outdoor areas.
- C. Smoke-free and tobacco-free regulations are promulgated under the New Mexico Clean Indoor Air Act, NMSA 1978, SS 24-13-1 through 24-16-11 (as amended 2007 by the Dee Johnson Clean Indoor Air Act) and Legislature of New Mexico Senate Memorial 63 (2013).

Violations by students are to be handled according to the college's policy on discipline.
